- Be 18 years of age or over
- Hold a minimum grade of 1st Kyu
- Have a good knowledge of your association's kyu grade syllabus

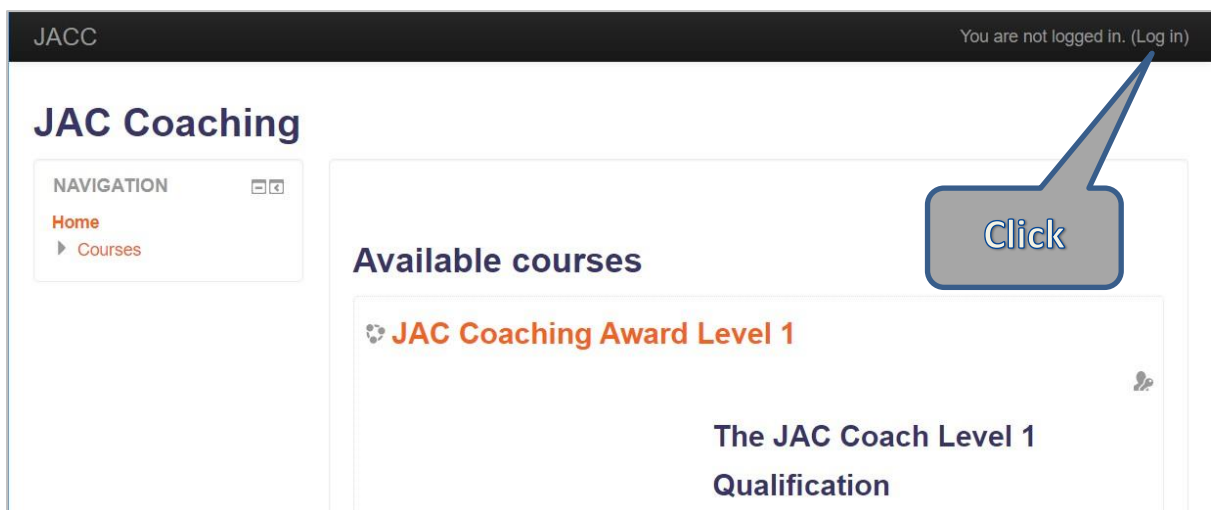
Notify your association's coaching tutor of your intention to study for the coaching award, complete the CL1 Coach application form and pay the course fee for online study.

On receipt of the course fee, the JAC will authorise your coach tutor to issue you with login credentials and you will then be able to access the online material located at www.jointaikikaicouncil.co.uk/jac-coaching/.
